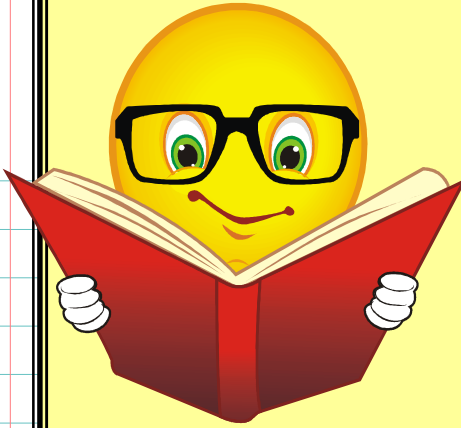

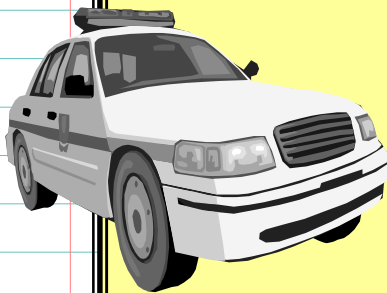

KIB's Great Indy Cleanup

KIB's *Great Indy Cleanup* is a litter program designed to combat heavy litter and debris that has accumulated in public spaces such as streets, alleys, greenspaces and waterways. The 2010 Great Indy Cleanup program runs weekends from April 24th through October 31st.
